Outstanding volunteer cheques, tracking volunteer hours

- How much food is needed for after-meet snack bags? Booster Club pay for snack back items rather than donations (better idea at end of the year)? Swimmers: protein, carb, drink; nothing that requires work; grab what you want and leave the rest
- Pizza Fundraiser Updates raised \$2600
 - ~\$2700 (495 items) in initial orders; couple of donations (~\$150), a few late-arriving orders
